
Cimelia Earhart spreads her wings



"Coming, Mother!" Amelia cried back. She took her toy plane and rushed inside.



"Father, Mother? Is it fine if I go to the Plane Show on Thursday?" Amelia gasped. Had she really just disturbed the prayer?


Mother sighed again. "My daughter is so un-ladylike." she thought.




The next morning, Amelia couldn't leave her room because her father told her she needs to think about her actions.

She snuck to the bathroom and found the door she would go out. She ran to the door and opened it. She dashed out the door to her friend's house.




